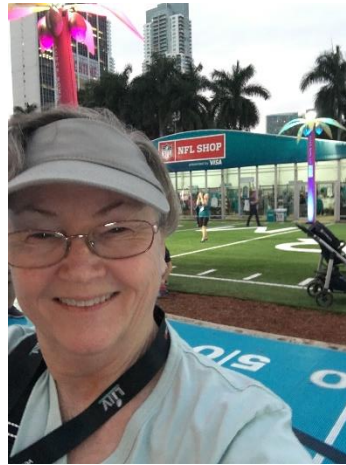


## January 25 to February 10, 2020
